# CONPELL PA100

2 component, fast curing, high solids, clear or coloured floor coating

#### **DESCRIPTION**

CONPELL PA100 is a two component, fast curing, high build clear or coloured floor coating ideal for both internal and external concrete surfaces. CONPELL PA100 has been specifically designed for use as a UV stable top coat for the CONPELL Epo Flake, Grip Rite and Epo Shield flooring systems, or as a fast cure coloured flooring system where fast return to service is required. CONPELL PA100 is available in a range of AS2700 colours, refer to the CONPELL colour card on the front page of the CONPELL website. Due to its unique design CONPELL PA100 is a hard wearing, durable coating, exhibiting good resistance to marking and staining.

#### **TYPICAL APPLICATIONS**

CONPELL PA100 can be used in a variety of applications, as a durable, hard wearing UV resistant clear top coat for the CONPELL Epo Flake, Grip Rite & Epo Shield epoxy flooring systems, or as a coloured flooring system for internal and external concrete surfaces that require a quick return to service.

#### **APPLICATION RATES**

Total application rates are typically 6 - 8m<sup>2</sup> per litre per coat. CONPELL PA100 can be applied as a 1, 2 or 3 coat system, the application rates and required coats will vary depending on the substrate and the finish required.

#### PACK SIZES

CONPELL PA100 is available in 30ltr and 6ltr pack sizes.

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#### **PREPARATION**

- All surfaces to be coated must be structurally sound and free of all previous coatings, adhesives, efflorescence or laitance by abrasive blasting, or mechanical grinding.
- All surfaces to be coated must be free of all dirt, grease, oil or other surface contaminants.
- All holes, non-structural cracks and surface deformities should be repaired prior to the application of CONPELL PA100.
- Very porous concrete may require a third coat of CONPELL PA100.
- Ensure re-coat times are adhered to between applications, re-coat times are 1.5 6 hours (depending on weather conditions), if re-coating occurs after 6 hours, the surface must be abraded prior to applying the next coat.

#### MIXING

- 1. Mixing should be by means of a mechanical forced action mixer with a high shear stirrer.
- 2. First, pre-mix each individual component to form a homogeneous paste.
- 3. Second, add 1 part B to 1 part A, mixing thoroughly for a minimum of 3 minutes until a homogeneous blended paste is achieved.
- 4. If diluting is required (recommended when applying directly to the concrete surfaces or when multiple coats are being applied) the mixed solution should be diluted 10 20% with Xylene.
- 5. Avoid trapping air during mixing.
- 6. Only mix enough product as can be used within the pot life of the product.

#### **PLACING**

- 1. Apply in a uniform manner using a brush or roller, ensure application rates are adhered to.
- 2. CONPELL PA100 can be applied from 1 to 3 coats depending on the substrate and the finish required.
- 3. Avoid pin holing.
- 4. Successive coats should be applied at right angles to the previous coats.
- 5. High humidity will reduce both the pot life and the curing time of CONPELL PA100.
- 6. Allow the surface to cure for a minimum of 12 hours before subjecting to pedestrian traffic, allow 3 days depending on conditions before allowing vehicular traffic or chemical cleaning.
- 7. To achieve an anti-slip finish, broadcast selected CONPELL aggregate into the coating while the coating is still wet prior to applying the final coat. Contact CONPELL for further information.
- 8. Full cure in 7 days.

#### CLEAN UP

CONPELL PA100 can be cleaned off all equipment prior to hardening with xylene.

#### **PRECAUTIONS**

- Some individuals may experience a skin reaction to CONPELL PA100. Use appropriate protection equipment. Refer to our Material Safety Data Sheet for further information.
- Do not apply directly to steel or metal surfaces as corrosion may occur.
- In enclosed areas ventilation should be provided during the coatings curing cycle to allow for adequate evaporation of the coating. CONPELL PA100 is a coating, not a water proofing membrane.
- Do not apply CONPELL PA100 over any existing concrete treatment such as curing compound or release agents. All contaminants must be removed prior to the application of CONPELL PA100.
- Apply CONPELL PA100 between 10°C 35°C.

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#### PRECAUTIONS (continued)

Contact the manufacturer if one or more of the following conditions exist:

- The substrate is subject to hydro static pressure or rising damp.
- The substrate is chalky or dusting.
- Ambient or substrate temperatures are below 10°C.
- The finished floor will be subject to chemical attack (including hot chicken fats).

#### **STORAGE**

- Keep CONPELL PA100 stored in a dry area, away from direct sunlight & frost.
- Store between 10°C & 30°C.
- CONPELL PA100 has a shelf life of 12 months in an unopened container.
- Ensure partly used drums are correctly sealed.

#### **FIRE**

CONPELL PA100 is non-flammable.

### **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS**

- Wear appropriate protective equipment, including clothing, gloves, appropriate respiratory mask and goggles.
- If poisoning occurs, contact doctor or Poisons Information Centre.
